Your daily experience will look like the follow:

DAY1

After Arrival to Ben Gurion Airport and pick up your luggage, You will be met by our representative who will Transfer you to your Hotel in Nazareth for dinner and Overnight.

DAY 2

Mediterranean Sea / Caesarea / Mount Carmel / Megiddo / Plain of Armageddon

After a good night of rest and a hearty breakfast, we board our motor coach to drive through the Jezreel Valley. We'll visit Megiddo and continue to the fields of Armageddon (Revelation 16:16), continuing northward along the Mediterranean Sea to Haifa and Mt. Carmel - the biblical site of Elijah's contest with the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Visit the Bahai Gardens in Haifa and tour the city then we'll head back to Nazareth for dinner and overnight.

DAY 3

Nazareth /Cana of Galilee/Mt Tabor/

The day starts with a tour of the Nazareth Village, a living presentation of the life, times and teaching of Jesus of Nazareth in a replica of ancient Nazareth. We will then explore the city of Nazareth, the hometown of Jesus, where we will visit the Church of the Annunciation (Luke 1:5-42) Then will be touring Cana of Galilee, the site of the first Miracle (John 2), a wedding renewal vows ceremony and worship can be arranged in Cana at Cana Wedding Chapel. Then we will visit Mount Tabor (mount of transfiguration-Luke 9) then we head back to our Hotel in Nazareth for dinner and overnight

DAY 4

Tiberias / Sea of Galilee / Capernaum / Mount of Beatitudes

We will spend an exciting day at the hot springs resort city of Tiberias. We will visit the Boat Museum then sail via boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum (John 6:24) to visit the ancient ruins of the first century synagogue where Jesus preached (Matthew 4:13-17). Then on to the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7). We will then proceed to upper Galilee and the site of Peter's confession (Matthew 16:16) at Caesarea Philippi (Banias Falls), the present day Golan Heights where Israel, Lebanon and Syria come together. After That we will visit Kursi, the site where Jesus casted out the demons from the Legion man. An optional baptismal service at Yardenit (Jordan River) can be arranged before going back to your Hotel for dinner.

DAY 5

Bet She'an/Dead Sea/ Jericho

After boarding our bus, we head south to visit Bet She'an, where the Biblical account of the battle of the Israelites against the Philistines on Mount Gilboa and the bodies of King Saul and his son Jonathan were hung on the walls of Bet She'an (1 Samuel 31:10). Then we pass by Jericho for a panoramic view of the mount of Temptation and then we drive to your hotel at the Dead Sea then for one of the most unique mud bathing and swimming experiences in the world. Dinner and overnight will be at your Hotel in Jerusalem.



DAY 6

Massada / Ein-Gedi / Jericho/Qumran

This morning we drive via the Judean Desert via beautiful new road takes us south along the shores of the Dead Sea to Masada, a truly remarkable piece of history. Ascend to Masada by cable car to visit the magnificent ruins of the fortress where from 70-73 A.D. the Jewish defenders made the last stand of the Judean Revolt against Rome and where the remains of storehouses, cisterns and a sixth century Byzantine church are still on view. Return along the Dead Sea to Ein-Gedi an oasis in the desert with fresh water springs. Around 1000 B.C., En Gedi served as one of the main places of refuge for David as he fled from Saul. David “dwelt in strongholds at En Gedi” (1 Sam. 23:29). In a cave near here, David cut off the corner of Saul’s robe (1 Sam 24), and then we will visit Qumran, where the Dead Sea scrolls were found before we head back to our Hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 7

Jerusalem / Old City / Temple Mount/ Garden Tomb

Today begins with a walking tour of the Old City of Jerusalem. Starting at the Western Wall (Wailing Wall), where the faithful Jews cry their petitions to God, we continue to the Temple Area of Mt. Moriah. Visit El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock that was built on the ancient site of Solomon’s Temple (Genesis 22:9-14) and over the Rock of Sacrifice where Abraham offering Isaac (Genesis 22) and the ceremonial sacrifice of animals took place. Then walk along the Via Dolorosa to Pilate’s Judgment Hall, the Chapel of the Flagellation, the Ecce Homo Arch (John 19:13) where Jesus was tried before Pilate (Mark 15:6). Then we will visit the Pool of Bethesda & St. Anne’s Church (John 5: 1-15) Then continue through the Old City bazaars to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher.

DAY 8

Jerusalem

After a night of rest and a hearty breakfast, this exciting day will begin with a drive to Mt. Scopus and the Mt. of Olives (Matthew 24:3) for a panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem and the Dominus Flevit. Walk along Hosanna Road to Gethsemane to visit the Church of All Nations, which stands on the Rock of Agony where Jesus was betrayed (Matthew 26: 26-57). See the Pillar of Absalom, the Eastern (Golden) Gate and the Pinnacle of the Temple, Walk in the old Market streets and head back to your Hotel for dinner and overnight.

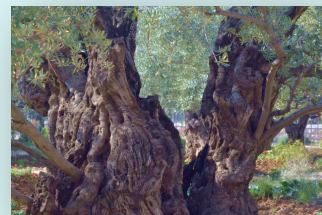
DAY 9

Bethlehem / Jerusalem /Yad Vashem/Israel museum

In the morning we will visit the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem, the birthplace of Jesus, and Shepherds Fields (Luke 2:1-20) then the Field of Boaz and Ruth (Ruth 1:16-17 and 4:13). We return to Jerusalem passing Rachel’s Tomb.

If time allows, we will visit the Valley of Elah (The Battle of David and Goliath) and spend some time there.

In the afternoon, we will visit Yad Vashem, the holocaust remembrance center, then the Israel Museum to visit the book of Shrines and the Model of Jerusalem.



Day 10

After breakfast, we leave Jerusalem to transfer Back to Ben Gurion Airport for departure.

The cost is \$3499 (you make your flight arrangement). For a Single room supplement, please add \$1550.

Rate Includes:

- Hotel Accommodation in 4 Stars Deluxe Hotels in Nazareth and for 5 nights in Jerusalem.
- Daily Buffet Breakfast and Dinner
- 8 Lunches including St Peter's fish Lunch and Nazareth Village first century lunch.
- All transfers by A/C deluxe motor coaches, Wi-Fi enabled all the way
- Evangelical English speaking Licensed tour Guide
- Meet and assist at Ben Gurion Airport upon arrival and departure (one time).
- Entrance fees to all the sites mentioned in the program, including Cable cars in Masada and Nazareth Village entrance fees
- Boat Ride at the Sea of Galilee
- All applicable Taxes
- Headsets
- Porters at the Hotels

The rate doesn't include:

- Any extras not mentioned
- Medical insurance (We highly recommended purchasing trip cancelation or interruption, medical expenses, and baggage insurance).
- Fees to issue ETA (As of January 1st, 2025, travelers to Israel must have a valid visa or ETA-IL approval before starting their journey)
- Any PCR tests required before arrival and upon arrival and Covid insurance that are required to enter Israel (until today there are no required tests)
- All Tips and Gratitudes
