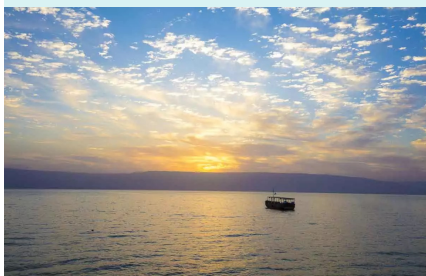

Below is Our Amazing Itinerary:

EARLY ARRIVAL

After Arrival to Ben Gurion Airport and picking up your luggage, You will be met by our representative who will Transfer you to your Hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and Overnight.

DAY 1, FREE DAY

DAY 2

Mt. of Olives/Hosanna Road/Gethsemane

After a night of rest and a hearty breakfast, this exciting day will begin with a drive to Mt. Scopus and the Mount of Olives (Matthew 24:3) for a panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem. Visit Dominus Flevit, then walk along Hosanna Road to Gethsemane to see the Church of All Nations, built on the Rock of Agony where Jesus was betrayed (Matthew 26:26-57). View the Pillar of Absalom, the Eastern (Golden) Gate, and the Pinnacle of the Temple. Stroll through the historic Old Market streets before returning to your hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

DAY 3

Garden Tomb/Church of the Nativity/Shepherd's Fields

In the Morning we visit the Garden Tomb and have a communion and worship service.

In the afternoon, visit the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem, the birthplace of Jesus, and Shepherds' Fields (Luke 2:1–20). See the Field of Boaz and Ruth (Ruth 1:16–17; 4:13) and pass by Rachel's Tomb on your return to Jerusalem.

DAY 4

Old Jerusalem/Wailing Wall/Temple Mount

Today begins with a walking tour of the Old City of Jerusalem, followed by a visit to the Western Wall (also known as the Wailing Wall), where faithful Jews offer their prayers. Continue to the Temple Mount, visiting Al-Aqsa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock, built on the ancient site of Solomon's Temple (Genesis 22:9–14) and over the Rock of Sacrifice where Abraham offered Isaac.

Walk along the Via Dolorosa to Pilate's Judgment Hall, the Chapel of the Flagellation, and the Ecce Homo Arch (John 19:13), where Jesus was tried before Pilate (Mark 15:6).

DAY 5

Holocaust Memorial/Dead Sea Scrolls/Pool of Bethesda

In the morning, visit Yad Vashem, Israel's official Holocaust memorial, followed by a visit to the Israel Museum to see the Shrine of the Book (housing the Dead Sea Scrolls) and the Model of Ancient Jerusalem.

Visit the Pool of Bethesda and St. Anne's Church (John 5:1–15), then continue through the Old City bazaars to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher.



DAY 6

Massada /Ein-Gedi /Qumran

This morning, travel through the Judean Desert along the shores of the Dead Sea to Masada — a remarkable site of ancient history. Ascend by cable car to visit the ruins of Herod's fortress, where Jewish defenders made their last stand against Rome (70–73 A.D.). See the remains of storehouses, cisterns, and a 6th-century Byzantine church.

Return along the Dead Sea to Ein Gedi, an oasis with fresh water springs where David sought refuge from King Saul (1 Samuel 23:29; 24). Then visit Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Return to your hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and an overnight stay.

DAY 7

Mediterranean Coast/Caesarea/Mount Carmel

After breakfast, drive along the Mediterranean coast to Caesarea Maritima, where you will visit the Crusaders' Fortress, the Roman Amphitheater, the ancient aqueduct, and the harbor from which the Apostle Paul sailed to Rome.

Continue north to Haifa to visit Mount Carmel, the site of Elijah's contest with the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18), and enjoy the view of the beautiful Bahai Gardens. Then continue to Nazareth for check-in, dinner, and overnight.



DAY 8

Tiberias / Sea of Galilee / Capernaum / Mount of Beatitudes / Golan Heights

Spend a memorable day exploring the Sea of Galilee region. Begin in Tiberias, take a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum (John 6:24), where Jesus preached in the synagogue (Matthew 4:13-17).

Continue to the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5–7). Travel north to Caesarea Philippi (Banias Falls), the site of Peter's confession (Matthew 16:16), located in the modern Golan Heights, where Israel, Lebanon, and Syria meet.

An optional baptismal service at the Yardenit (Jordan River) can be arranged before returning to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 9

Nazareth / Cana of Galilee /

Begin the day at Nazareth Village, a living reconstruction of first-century Nazareth, depicting the life and teachings of Jesus. Continue to explore Nazareth — visit the Church of the Annunciation (Luke 1:5–42), the Synagogue Church (Luke 4), and Mary's Well. Then continue to Cana of Galilee, the site of Jesus' first miracle (John 2:1–11). Return to your hotel for dinner and an overnight stay. Finally, we will stop at Mount Precipice for a breathtaking view of the Jezreel Valley and reflect on Luke 4:29-30 before visiting Megiddo.

DAY 10 (RETURN HOME)

The cost is \$3695 (you make your flight arrangement). For a Single room supplement, please add \$1550. I am capping this at 20 people. A \$300 non-refundable deposit secures your spot.

Rate Includes:

- Hotel Accommodation in 4 Stars Deluxe Hotels in Nazareth and in Jerusalem.
- Daily Buffet Breakfast and Daily Dinner
- 8 Lunches including St Peter's fish Lunch and Nazareth Village first century lunch.
- All transfers by A/C deluxe motor coaches, Wi-Fi enabled all the way
- Evangelical English speaking Licensed tour Guide
- Meet and assist at Ben Gurion Airport upon arrival and departure (one time).
- Entrance fees to all the sites mentioned in the program, including Cable cars in Masada and Nazareth Village entrance fees
- Boat Ride at the Sea of Galilee
- All applicable Taxes
- Headsets
- Porters at the Hotels

The rate doesn't include:

- Any extras not mentioned
- Medical insurance (We highly recommended purchasing trip cancelation or interruption, medical expenses, and baggage insurance).
- Fees to issue ETA (As of January 1st, 2025, travelers to Israel must have a valid visa or ETA-IL approval before starting their journey)
- All Tips and Gratuities
